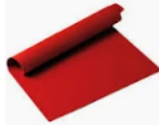
Be Informed

ROOM HEATING

- ◆ Fall is upon us. This means weather is now getting colder. The plan is to turn on the heaters the first week of October.
- ◆ You will receive an email notification once the heaters are activated.
- ◆ As a reminder, keep windows closed to prevent additional pressure on the heating system.



EXPANDED COOKING CAPABILITY



Heat resistant silicone cooking mats rated at 450F have been issued in all rooms except for Building 2701 where cooking is prohibited due to the absence of fire suppressant system. Along with the mats is the Expanded Cooking policy which lists what cooking equipment is authorized and unauthorized in your room.

REFRIGERATOR LOCK BOXES

Tenants over 21 years of age are allowed to have alcohol in their room, however, in shared rooms with tenants under 21 years of age, all alcoholic beverages will be secured in a locked container when the tenant who is 21 or older is not present. Our 21 and older tenants then ask, "How can I be at work all day and not be able to come home and have a cold alcoholic beverage"? We hear you and are taking steps to procure refrigerator lock boxes that you can choose to be accountable for. There will be more on this subject as the procurement process unfolds, however, if you wish not to wait for the procurement process to take place you have the option to purchase a lock box and retain it as your personal property. Refrigerator Lock Boxes can be found by Google search and are reasonably priced between \$20-\$30.



In the meantime, those authorized to possess alcohol, keep it under lock and key in shared rooms when your roommate is under 21 and you are not present!

BUILDING 2701 RENOVATION PROJECT

Phase 1 of the renovation project in Bldg. 2701 is nearing completion. C&D wing is currently on track for furniture installation in October and scheduled for occupancy between November or December. For this phase, there will be two common kitchens and six laundry rooms. A&B wing is on phase 2 of the renovation and is expected to be completed within a year.

THERE'S A PEST IN YOUR ROOM?! Better Call the Front Desk!



To avoid insects/pests in your room, you must eliminate their survival sources (food, water and shelter) as much as possible. Sanitation habits play a very important role in pest prevention:

- Wash and put away dishes after use; ensure sink is dry and appliances are wiped down
- Ensure countertops are free of food crumbs and clutter
- Ensure floor is free of food crumbs and mop at least once a week
- Take out trash containing food items or if more than half full
- Throw away unneeded items (papers, boxes, old clothes, expired food)
- Periodically check for moisture problems (along window sills, in the bathroom, under the sink)

Call the UH Front Desk as soon as you see any evidence of pests in your room. Do not apply any kind of insecticides as our contractor uses Navy approved products only.

As Agreed and Signed Upon Check-in, all residents "MUST" immediately report to UH staff any suspicious activity or unauthorized items and/or personnel in the UH property. Resident Advisors are also available if needed. **Know your RA!**
