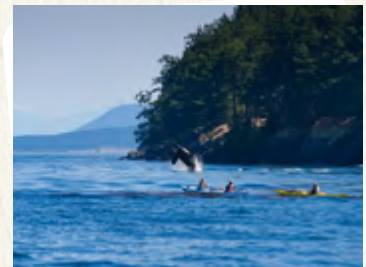


### RENTAL POLICIES

- Renters are responsible for loading, ensuring safe transportation, and unloading rental equipment.
- Towed equipment. Proof of insurance is required for towed equipment. The liability and damages incurred when towing are the Renter's responsibility. The towing vehicle must meet the towed equipment's specifications. Renters make all trailer connections under the supervision of an MWR staff member.
- Sit-in kayaks require Renters to provide proof of completing a watercraft safety class.
- Pets and smoking are not allowed in or on tents, pads, and sleeping bags. Renters pay cleaning fees for equipment returned with smoke odor, pet odor or hair.
- Renters or a family member must return equipment to the issuing facility during their normal hours of operation.
- Late returns. Renters pay the normal rental rates for equipment returned late or after hours.
- Renters agree to return equipment in the same condition as issued, less normal wear and tear. Renters are liable and responsible for the loss, theft, or damage of the rental equipment. If the equipment is damaged, lost, or stolen the Renter will pay full retail replacement or all repair costs whether the Renter was at fault or not, including acts of nature.
- Renters agree to pay repair or replacement costs for lost, stolen, or damaged equipment. Damage repair rates are \$35 per hour for labor plus parts. If MWR is not able to make repairs, the equipment will be taken to a dealer or repair shop, and the renter will be invoiced for all costs.
- A minimum cleaning or drying fee of \$20 charged for equipment returned wet or dirty.
- Early returns are not credited or refunded.

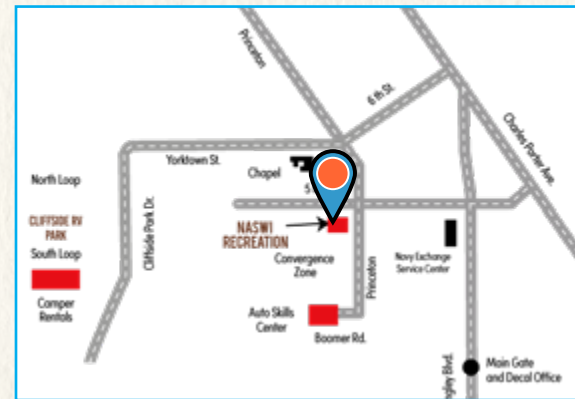
