EXPANDED COOKING

The Installation CO may authorize cooking beyond the designated kitchen area using authorized small cooking appliances with some exceptions (i.e. appliances that produce grease-laden vapors, expose heating sources, use compressed gas, create excessive smoke, or utilize open flames).

See your UH staff for a list of approved and prohibited small cooking appliances and any installation appliance tagging requirements to identify the appliance is authorized for use.

Your UH staff also has heat mats to issue for the protection of cooking surfaces and fire hazards.

HEATING SYSTEM FACTS

- **BLDG. 2026/2027/2028:** Water is heated in a boiler and circulated through the building to the tube/fin heating units in each room. Building heating system should maintain your rooms at 68-70°F. You can adjust your thermostat as needed.
- **BLDG. 2029:** Water is heated in a boiler and circulated through the building to the tube/fin heating units in each room. Your rooms should maintain 70-74°F automatically all year round.

IN ORDER FOR OUR HEATING SYSTEM TO WORK EFFECTIVELY DURING WINTER SEASON, WINDOWS MUST BE KEPT CLOSED AT ALL TIMES.

If you notice a draft or cold air coming in around the window, place a Maintenance Request immediately.

Do You Know???

Shower Tile Steam Cleaning—It really works folks! We've purchased a commercial steamer to help clean ceramic tiles in Bldgs. 2026, 2027 & 2028. If you'd like us to steam clean your shower stall, we'll do it for you. We need a few things from you first:

- >Call the Front Desk and schedule during the workweek (0900-1400). We'll provide confirmation if requested time and day is good. Process takes ~30-40 minutes.
- >Remove grime by scrubbing the walls with scrub brush and cleaning solution (you'll need to purchase these). We will not steam clean if this is not completed.
- >Clear the shower stall the day of scheduled cleaning.

Refrigerator Freezer Defrosting—We are experiencing many refrigerator service requests from 2026 and 2027 stating that the refrigerator side is not cooling. We concluded that the majority of the problem is caused by freezer overload or a freezer that needs defrosting. If this occurs in your unit, put in a QR request or stop by the Front Desk and we'll provide freezer defrosting step-by-step procedures.

We Live in Washington State That's Known for Rain—If will be away for more than a day, please remember to close your windows. You never know when it will rain in our area, and the expensive cost to replace furniture or carpet damaged by water will be your responsibility.

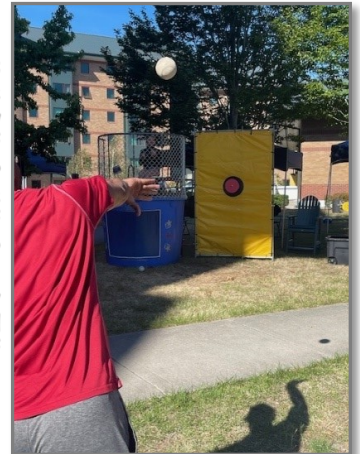
ANNUAL TENANT SATISFACTION SURVEY

ARE THERE PESTS IN YOUR ROOM?!

To avoid pests in your room, you must eliminate their survival sources (food, water, shelter) as much as possible. Good Sanitation habits play a very important role in pest prevention.



SINGLE BASIC ALLOWANCE FOR HOUSING

- 1) Member routes SBAH request through chain of command. Lease and/or tentative address ARE NOT required. Annotate on request start date "upon move out of UH". Ensure package is complete including LES (actual paid and not frocked); and completely signed-off Encl. (3).
- 2) Forward to UH for 2nd endorsement.
- 3) UH will forward to NSE admin and will Cc ship's CPPA/POC.
- 4) Once approved, NSE admin will send signed approval letter to ship CPPA/POC.
- 5) Member will provide UH front desk copy of approval letter and schedule a move out inspection. Member cannot check out without the approved letter signed by the base CO.
